Hugo's currently has ten supermarkets, five liquor stores, seven Caribou Coffee shops, and three pharmacies in North Dakota and Minnesota. Hugo's employs 1,200 associates.

Kristi is a dedicated member of the MGA and numerous groups in their community. She serves on the boards of the Minnesota Grocers Association, National Grocers Association, North Dakota Grocers Association, and the Prairie Harvest Foundation.

Kristi and her husband Bob have been married 13 years. They live in Grand Forks with her stepdaughter Juliana and their three dogs.
