You can:

- Go to the grocery store
- Go to medical appointments and the pharmacy
- Get take-out, delivery or drive through from nearby restaurants
- Walk your dog, ride your bike, be in nature
- Pick up essentials for neighbors or loved ones in need of assistance

Please keep 6ft between yourself and others

You should not:

- Go to work unless providing an essential service
- Socialize or gather in groups
- Visit loved ones in the hospital or nursing home, except under limited circumstances.
