## Minnesota Grocers Association Presents 2023 MGA Legislator of the Year Award to Representative Robbins

St. Paul, MN – February 1, 2023 – The Minnesota Grocers Association (MGA) presented its 2023 MGA Legislator of the Year award to Representative Kristin Robbins (R – Maple Grove) at its annual Legislative Dinner on January 31, 2023, at the St. Paul Hotel in St. Paul, MN.

Each year, the Minnesota Grocers Association acknowledges a lawmaker who demonstrates outstanding commitment to the food industry. The 2023 MGA Legislator of the Year award went to Representative Robbins for her championing of the MGA's top legislative priority - the refilling of the Unemployment Insurance Trust Fund. Her bill allocated Federal relief dollars to the UITF, which would prevent Minnesota businesses from being hit with increased taxes and surcharges. Robbins also authored a bill that would allow employers to receive a Workforce Training Credit for eligible expenses for direct costs of training paid by an employer to train an employee.

"Representative Robbins fought tirelessly last session in promoting legislation that creates jobs and careers for her constituents. She displayed outstanding commitment in advocating for common sense policies that spur economic activity and help our neighbors keep their shopping baskets full," said Jamie Pfuhl, President of the MGA. "This award is a testament to her vision, leadership, and support of the entire industry from farm to fork."
